

Dear Neighbours,

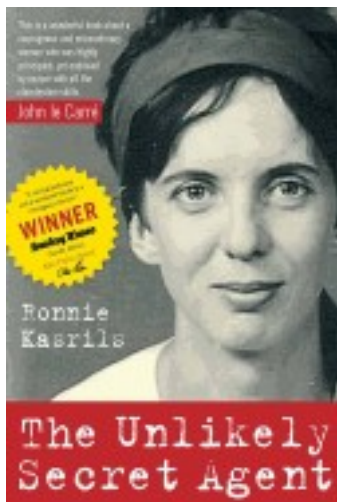
